Message from the Pastor

"I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If any man eats of this bread, he shall live for ever; and the bread that I will give, is my flesh, for the life of the world." (John 6.51) This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi. It is three feasts in one: the feast of the Eucharistic sacrifice, the feast of the Sacrament of the Eucharist and the feast of the Real Presence of Jesus in this Sacrament. Corpus Christi is a doctrinal feast established for three purposes: 1) to give God collective thanks for Christ's abiding presence with us in the Eucharist and to honor Him there; 2) to instruct the people in the Mystery, Faith and devotion surrounding the Eucharist, and 3) to teach us to appreciate and make use of the great gift of the Holy Eucharist, both as a Sacrament and as a sacrifice. In this Feast we celebrate Christ's gift to us of the Eucharist, the source and summit of our life together as the Church. Second Vatican Council teaches: "the Holy Eucharist is the center and culmination of Christian life" (Lumen Gentium 11). The Eucharist enables us to participate in Christ's sacrifice as a present reality and to benefit from its fruits in our own lives; it helps us to worship the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in the most perfect way; it strengthens our charity and unity with Jesus and each other in a joint offering of his Body and Blood to the Father; and it gives us a lasting memorial of Christ's suffering, death and Resurrection, reminding us of our obligation to make loving sacrifices for others. The Eucharist is the Mystery of our Faith, the mystery of our Hope, the mystery of our Charity. St. Augustine said: "It is your Mystery, the Mystery of your life that has been placed on the altar." The Feast invites us today to offer ourselves on the altar to be transformed as Eucharist or as body of Christ to be broken and to be shared for others. The Feast teaches us of the importance of unity and sacrificial love in Christian life. Just as numerous grains of wheat are pounded together to make the host, and many grapes are crushed together to make the wine, so we become unified in this sacrifice. That which unites us is our willingness to sacrifice our time and talents to God in our fellow members in Christ's Mystical Body. This is symbolized by our sharing in the same Bread and the same Cup. Hence, Holy Communion should strengthen our sense of unity and love. Let us love the Eucharist...Let us adore and worship Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Let us pray with St. Thomas Aquinas: "O Sacrament most holy! O Sacrament Divine! All praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine!"

<u>Priests' Annual General Assembly</u>: As Fr. Eugene and Fr. Sunny are attending the Diocesan Priests' annual General Assembly from June 12 to 14 (Monday to Wednesday) there won't be Holy Mass on **Monday and Tuesday** (June 12 & 13).

Prayer of Consecration

And, at the end, when death comes to take any one of us away, may we accept it with submission and with joyful hope in the resurrection and the final reunion of our family in heaven, where your own hand will wipe away every tear from our eyes. Mary, Mother of Jesus, be the mother of this family. St. Joseph, take care of each member of this family as you looked after the Holy Family of Nazareth. May the grace and blessing of the Sacred Heart of Jesus be on us; the peace of the Sacred Heart envelope us; the merits of the Sacred Heart plead for us; the love of the Sacred Heart strengthen us; the zeal of the Sacred Heart animate us; the virtues of the Sacred Heart shine forth in our words and deeds; and may the beatific vision of the Sacred heart be our eternal joy. Sacred Heart of Jesus, be King of our home. In our home you be glorified today and forever." (Daily Prayers)
