Message from the Pastor:

"...I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Mathew.28:20) There is a beautiful old story: Jesus, after his Ascension into Heaven, was surrounded by the Holy Angels who began to enquire about his work on earth. Jesus told them about his birth, life, preaching, death, and Resurrection, and how he had accomplished the salvation of the world. The Archangel Gabriel asked, "Well, now that you are back in Heaven, who will continue your work on earth?" Jesus said, "While I was on earth, I gathered a group of people around me who believed in me and loved me. They will continue to spread the Gospel and carry on the work of the Church." Gabriel was perplexed. "You mean Peter, who denied you thrice and all the rest who ran away when you were crucified? You mean to tell us that you left them to carry on your work? And what will you do if this plan doesn't work? What's your Plan B?" Jesus said, "I have no other plan — it must work." — Truly, Jesus has no other plan than to depend on the efforts of his followers.

The Feast of the Ascension of Jesus Christ reminds us of Jesus' exaltation and the end of his earthly existence, as a prelude to the gift of the Holy Spirit. Before His Ascension, Jesus entrusted the continuation of His earthly mission to his disciples promising them of His continuing presence with them and the whole world, saying, "...I am with you always, to the end of the age." He gave them the mission of preaching the Good News and evangelizing the whole world by bearing witness to him through their words and lives. He also promised them the gift of the Holy Spirit who would enable them to preach the Gospel and to bear witness to Jesus by keeping and living out his word. As Christian disciples we are called to carry out the mission of Jesus to preach the Gospel in word and deed and be true witnesses to him in this world. We are assured of the guidance by the Holy Spirit and God's protection even amid suffering and in the face of death. As in the story, Jesus has no Plan-B...He places all His trust in us and depend on us to carry out His mission to the "ends of the earth."
